
The Value of Community Dental Health Coordinators



Based on a 6-month pilot of CDHCs in four Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs)



A Community Dental Health Coordinator (CDHC) acts as a bridge between the community and clinical care with a working knowledge of dental disease processes, the dental delivery system and disease prevention strategies.

Connecting to Care –



12 CDHCs connected over **6,000 patients** to comprehensive dental care.



In Virginia, **1 CDHC** connected **184 children** aged 0-3 to comprehensive dental care.





At 1 FQHC in New Jersey, CDHCs increased the overall HPV vaccine rates by 19%.
