<sup>4</sup> **West Virginia** is a member of both NERB and SRTA.

<sup>5</sup> **Nevada** also accept results of the WREB examination.

<sup>6</sup> **California** administers its own examination and also has joined WREB. Legislation to join WREB addresses only the dental examination, not the dental hygiene examination.

<sup>7</sup> **South Carolina** is a member of both CRDTS and SRTA.

<sup>8</sup> **Missouri** is a member of both CRDTS and WREB.

<sup>9</sup> **New York**, though still a member of NERB, no longer accepts results of a clinical examination for the purposes of license. Applicants must instead complete a postgraduate year of study in an ADA- accredited residency program that is at least one year in length (PGY-1).
